STREET CLOSURE NOTICE

In recent years, traffic flow at the corner of Alexander and Coveland during festival weekend has been hazardous, putting both festival attendees and drivers at risk for injury. In the interest of public safety, it was agreed upon by the Town of Coupeville and the Coupeville Festival Association to close Alexander and Coveland to through traffic from 5:00 PM, Friday August 13th, through 8:00 PM, Sunday August 15th, 2010. We recognize this is a change that will impact our local community and ask for your support and understanding as we transition to this safer process.

Please review the details listed below to prepare:

- **Alexander Street** will be closed to through traffic at 8th Street (Library)
- **Coveland** will be closed to through traffic at Main and at the Post Office (Post Office access via Hwy 20/Broadway)
- **Front Street** will remain closed from Saturday morning 2:00 AM through Sunday evening 8:00 PM
- Island Transit will relocate the bus stop at Alexander to the corner of **9th and Main** for Saturday

Volunteers manning the barricades will receive training prior to the festival to assist visitors and our community in problem solving access to local services.

Please note:

The barricade on Coveland at the Post Office will move to Christopher's parking lot after 6PM Saturday and 5 PM Sunday. This permits evening access to Christopher's and the fueling station on Coveland.
