- **No construction waste from contractors!***
- **No Household Garbage!** We cannot accept bags of garbage.
- **We do not accept tires, appliances.**
- **We do not accept recyclables** (newspapers, plastic containers, cardboard). They may be taken to the Island County Landfill recycling center at no charge.
- **We do not accept paints, chemicals, gasoline or motor oil.** These items may be taken to the Island County Landfill at no charge.

This service is limited to Town residents only - bring a copy of your water bill and identification showing your address. This project is paid for with taxpayer dollars and must be restricted to Town of Coupeville residents.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING BEGINS IN FEBRUARY

The Town Council approved a new contract with Island Disposal, which renews the contract to provide garbage collection to all residences and businesses in the Town limits, and adds curbside recycling to the service.

Island Disposal began distributing recycling carts the week of January 28, 2013. Included with the cart was a brochure about what items can be recycled. Actual collection of recycling will begin February 4 for some locations and February 11 for others. Garbage and recycling will be picked up on Mondays. Recycling pick up will be every other week. If you have questions about the schedule for pickup for recycling for your location, please contact Island Disposal at 678-5701.

Town Code requires all homes and businesses to have garbage collection. Each occupant may choose the level of garbage service with a minimum of one can once a month. The new recycling service will happen every two weeks, and is also required.

Residential customers who have one 32 gallon garbage can picked up weekly will pay \$24.00 per month plus taxes, which includes recycling service. Many customers will likely find that they can reduce the number of garbage pickups they have each month, since using the recycling bin will take a lot of volume out of the regular garbage can. Reducing the number of cans or weeks that cans are picked up will reduce the monthly fee. If you have questions or want to adjust your service, please contact Island Disposal at 678-5701.

Island Disposal will work directly with multi-family housing units, and large commercial customers, to customize the recycle pickup for their location needs.

Island Disposal will not pick up glass in the recycle bins. On a trial basis, a recycle bin for glass will be located at the Town Public Works Shop at 205 N. Main St. Coupeville residents and businesses may drop glass at that location.

The move to recycling a significant amount of our waste products will help the Town in achieving its goal of reducing carbon emissions by a total of 20%, and is estimated to reduce the amount of recyclables in the waste stream by 10-50%.
