- **No construction waste from contractors!***
- **No Household Garbage!** We cannot accept bags of garbage.
- **We do not accept tires, appliances.**
- **We do not accept recyclables** (newspapers, plastic containers, cardboard). They may be taken to the Island County Landfill recycling center at no charge.
- **We do not accept paints, chemicals, gasoline or motor oil.** These items may be taken to the Island County Landfill at no charge.

This service is limited to Town residents only - bring a copy of your water bill and identification showing your address. This project is paid for with taxpayer dollars and must be restricted to Town of Coupeville residents.

9TH STREET TRAIL EXTENSION

One more link in the walking trail along 9th Street has been completed! Many thanks to new property owners Lew and Jeannie Legat, who provided an easement to the Town which allowed us to continue the path at the corner by the hill going up Parker Road. This curve has been a bad spot for pedestrians. Walkers were on the trail as fast as the gravel was going down... it looks like it will be well used! Construction of the trail was done by Town staff: Kelly Riepma, Public Works Superintendent and Dan Dalton, Maintenance Worker. We hope to connect the new section through to Captain Coupe Park and the boat launch later this year; which will give us a path along the entire north side of the Town: Front Street to 9th to Parker.

BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS An Opportunity to Participate

There are many opportunities to take an active role in your local government. The Town of Coupeville has several citizen boards and commissions on which residents help shape the future of our community by serving in advisory capacities to the Coupeville Town Council. There are current vacancies or terms due for renewal on the following groups. PLANNING COMMISSION

- *Five members: Three positions due for renewal or new appointment*
- *Town residency required for three members; two members may reside outside the town limits but must be registered voters in Island County and own and operate a business within the town limits.*
- *Currently meets first Tuesday of each month, 6:30 p.m.*
- *Term: Four years*

Responsible for preparing and recommending amendments to the Town's Comprehensive Plan. Make recommendations to the Town Council regarding changes to zoning and other land use regulations. Make recommendations to Town Council on land use applications.

LIBRARY BOARD

- *Five members: One position due for renewal or new appointment*
- *Currently meets third Tuesday evening of each month*
- *Term: Five years*

Sets policy to govern operations and programs of the library. Serves in an advisory capacity to the Town and Sno-Isle Regional Library District.

PARKS & RECREATION BOARD

- *Seven members: All positions due for renewal or new appointment*
 - *Town residency required*
 - *Meets as needed*
 - *Term: Three years*
- Reviews recreational needs for residents and makes recommendations on beautification and management of parks, recreation areas and facilities.

TREE BOARD

- *Three members: All new appointments*
- *Meets as needed*

The Tree Board is responsible for considering nominations for Heritage Tree Status and submitting recommendations to the Town Council.

SELECTION PROCESS

All applicants will be interviewed by the Mayor and a member of the Town Council. The Mayor will recommend appointments to the Town Council for their approval.

Applications are due February 28, 2014.
